**3. Poll Stations**

This year, as many of you are already aware, Elections McGill had only one official poll station located in the Shatner lobby. Many councilors expressed their concerns regarding the effect of this decision on voter participation. Evidently, as was demonstrated in Section 1 of this report, the overall turnout increased significantly by spending the resources usually allocated to poll stations, differently. 18% of the student population (thus quorum) had already voted before Monday morning when our poll station set up shop, further supporting our decision to cut down on poll stations this year.


