Referendum Re: Constitutional Amendment:

Whereas the title of Chief Returning Officer is a misnomer and meaningless,

Whereas the Chief Electoral Officer is the title used by Elections Canada and other Electoral Agencies,

Do you agree to the following constitutional amendments?

All references to Chief Returning Officer or CRO be changed to Chief Electoral Officer or CEO.

All references to Deputy Returning Officer or DRO be changed to Deputy Chief Electoral Officer or DCEO

Online Opt-Outs Referendum:

Whereas these students groups and fees at McGill including, but not limited to, the SSMU Referral Services Fee (funding Queer McGill, McGill Nightline, and the Union for Gender Empowerment), Midnight Kitchen, QPIRG, SSMU Library fund, SSMU Environment Fee, SSMU Campus Life Fund, SSMU Bursary Fund, Radio CKUT, QPIRG, McGill Tribune, Arts Student Employment Fund, and the Arts Undergraduate Improvement Fund, each contribute uniquely to student life and learning on McGill campus;

Whereas these student groups are committed to keeping online opt-outs accessible to students;

Whereas the opt-out system created and administered by the McGill administration denies these student groups the right to administer their own fees;

Do you support the principle that these McGill student groups should be able to autonomously design and administer their own accessible online opt-out system?

Nomination of Auditors Referendum:

Whereas the SSMU is required, by both the Corporations Act and its Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) with McGill University, to produce annual audited financial statements; and

Whereas the nomination of auditors was presented at the regular Winter General Assembly, which failed to attain quorum; and

Whereas the auditors must be nominated in order to perform an audit of the SSMU; and

Whereas the SSMU has contracted the services of the auditing firm of Chamberland Hodge for the past 3 years;
